Minutes of Meeting March 9, 2015 Truro Public Safety Facility

The meeting commenced at 6:00 p.m. with a quorum and covered the following agenda:

- 1. **Meeting minutes** of the January 12, 2014 meeting were approved.
- Public comments: None.
- 3. Outer Cape Bike and Pedestrian Master Plan status: Representatives from Mass DoT were in attendance at the last meeting. The proposal to stripe bike lanes on Route 6 was discussed. Mass DoT is now allowing towns to petition for pedestrian activated stop lights, if the town provides funding. Representatives from CCNS raised the possibility of funding through the Seashore in certain locations. The next public meeting is tentatively scheduled for March 26 in Wellfleet.
- 4. **Mass DOT letter for Route 6 bike lane markings:** Karen Snow attended the Board of Selectmen meeting on Jan 27 and presented the letter, which was approved and sent to Mass DoT. No response has been received as yet. Cathy Haynes to follow up with Wellfleet BWW committee
- 5. **Review 2015 goals and priorities:** Discussed the following topics: pedestrian activated walkways; tracking Mass DoT road projects in Truro; CCRTA bike carrying capacity; encouraging bike rack installation on private property; school programs; outreach via Provincetown Banner.
- 6. **Expenditures for 2015:** The brochure is ready to be printed when the current supply runs out. A \$300 donation was received from the Truro Police Association. No response from the Barnstable County procurement office.
- 7. **Next meeting** is scheduled for April 7, 2015 at 5:30 p.m. at the Truro Public Safety Facility.
