2. Joseph Fiorello, 7 Pond Road, Request for Hearing and Extension of July 31, 2017 Order to Correct for Violations of 105 CMR 410.00, State Sanitary Code Chapter II, Minimum Standards of Fitness for Human Habitation

Joseph Fiorello, Trustee of the property, approached the Board. Ms. Rose requested Ms. Beebe to give a summary of the situation. Ms. Beebe read an inspection report which contain all the corrections needed to be done by the Applicant. She also stated that no one is currently living in the building and that the inspection was initiated by a complaint from someone in the neighborhood. Mr. Fiorello stated that the immediate concerns were addressed right away but some of the others will take time and money. He also mentioned that two students did stay in the back apartment this summer as a favor to a friend. Mr. Fiorello informed the Board that at this point in time, he has no plan for the property. Mr. Fiorello requested an additional 30 days to get the additional items listed on the Order to Correct finished.

Mr. Peters moved to amend the Order to Correct and give the Applicant an additional 30 days to correct the remaining items, meet with Mr. Braun, Building Commissioner, and come back before the Board to discuss his eventual plans for the property and the progress to date, with the condition that the property not be occupied.
