----- -- OLD NORTH CEMETERY on the HILL OF STORMS

-- NOT ALL BURIALS HAD STONES--Colonist were not very wealthy and it takes  
someone with money to afford a stone

-- BURIED WITHOUT CLOTHES, making garments too labor extensive to waste, The sheep  
had to be sheared, the wool washed, the fibers smoothed, the wool spun, the cloth cut

-- MAUSELEUM ( 3 ), Winter Storage, ----, Old North, Congregational, & Pinegrove Cemeteries

\* ISSAC MORTON SMALL developed the Highland recreation area in the late 1800's  
guess house restaurant, golf course, carriage > railroad station  
( railroad Boston to Provincetown 1873 to 1939-----freight to 1960 )
