- <u>Ballston Beach, South Pamet Road; Town of Truro</u>; SE#75-1000; removal of a portion of existing paved parking lot at Ballston beach. All work proposed w/in Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage & Barrier Beach, and portion of project is within a Coastal Dune.
- <u>135 South Pamet Road, Basil Musnuff; SE#75-1001</u>; removal of a jeep from garage that is buried by windblown sand. All work proposed w/in Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage & Barrier Beach, and portion of project is within a Coastal Dune.
