PUBLIC HEARINGS:

The Truro Conservation Commission holds the following public hearings in accordance with the provisions of MGL Ch. 131, s. 40, the Wetlands Protection Act and the Truro Conservation Bylaw, Chapter 8:

NOTICE OF INTENT:

- **Ballston Beach, South Pamet Road; Town of Truro ; SE#75-1000;** removal of a portion of existing paved parking lot at Ballston beach. All work proposed w/in Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage & Barrier Beach, and portion of project is within a Coastal Dune.
- **135 South Pamet Road, Basil Musnuff; SE#75-1001;** removal of a jeep from garage that is buried by windblown sand. All work proposed w/in Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage & Barrier Beach, and portion of project is within a Coastal Dune.

- **618 Shore Road:** Eric Shapiro, Lexvest Group; trenching for underground utilities (map 5, parcel 13)
- **271 Shore Road:** Sherry Wilkinson; trenching for underground utilities (map 13, parcel 12 and 22 and Shore road)
