APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes of the previous THA meeting on June 13, 2019 were approved. Moved Kevin Grunwald; second Carl Brotman. Unanimous.

UPDATE ON CLOVERLEAF PROJECT/SITE VISIT. The application to Mass Works for infrastructure on the project: water and road work is due August 9th. An intern at Mass Housing, Nicholas Pittman, who is studying Urban Planning, is interviewing Kevin Grunwald and Carl Brotman on the Cloverleaf site. The interview will be filmed.

RECAP OF THE TRURO CONNECTIONS EVENT. The talk at the Payomet tent on the need for affordable housing on the cape was excellent and attended by a small group of residents interested in affordable housing issues.

DISCUSSION OF THE WALSH PROPERTY COMMUNITY FORUM. The forum was attended by Truro residents and the Select Board and moderated by a trained facilitator. Many ideas were generated which will be summarized by the facilitator. This forum was the beginning of a process to bring Truro citizens together from all parts of the community to decide how to best use this property.

APPOINTMENT OF MARY ROSE AS THE THA REPRESENTATIVE TO THE COM-MUNITY PRESERVATION COUNCIL (CPC). Mary Rose was unanimously approved to represent the THA on the CPC for 3 years until June 20, 2022. Moved: Susan Todd; second: Carl Brotman.
