Halloween Event- Friday 10/28/22 5-7 pm recreation hired photo booth, face painter, supplying a popcorn machine.

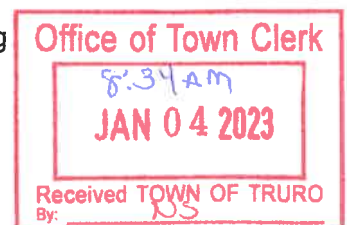
Christmas Event/Collaboration with Truro Police Department
