Michael Britt has been working with the appropriate staff and a vendor to determine if one or more pieces might be added with the balance of our FY19 operating budget. As this agenda is prepared, we have prices on the equipment and installation, but not for a continuation of the rubber surface on the existing playground (that can be added later). Specifically, we would install an additional four-bay swing set, and swap the new accessible swing with one on the existing set (which is on the accessible rubber surface). This will allow twice as many children to swing at a time, and make the current unit accessible. We also would add two in ground game tables, and a bowling set, all for under \$9,900. A vote to approve this is necessary.
