

TRURO TRANSFER STATION PERMITS

OVERVIEW

Permits for the Truro Transfer Station are now available online or may be purchased at the Beach Office 7 days per week beginning June 10, 2017. Prior to June 10th, you may also purchase stickers at the Truro Town Hall at the Licensing Office from Monday through Friday, 8 am– 4 pm.

Please note that there is a convenience fee charged by the processing company for online transactions. If you prefer not to pay this charge, you may purchase your permit at the Town Hall or at the Beach Office during the hours specified.

ITEMS YOU WILL NEED TO PURCHASE A STICKER

- Vehicle registration
If your vehicle is leased or rented, you will also need a copy of the lease or rental agreement demonstrating that you are the person renting the vehicle.
- Proof of residency (unless listed as an owner/ trustee in the Assessor's Database or unless your vehicle registration has a Truro address. Please see the Board of Health Regulations for a complete list of ways to prove residency.
- If purchasing online, an email address is required.
- Cash, check or credit card. Please note that online transactions can only be completed with a credit card.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Have the fees increased for Transfer Station Stickers?

Fees were increased in 2016. They have not increased for the 2017 permits.

Is my sticker for my annual Transfer Station permit still valid?

Annual stickers purchased from July 1, 2016 on are valid through June 30, 2017.

Do I have to drive to the Beach Office or Town Hall to purchase my permit?

Nope! As long as you have access to a computer with internet access where you can scan documents or a smart phone or smart device (like an iPad or other devices that allow you to take pictures), you can obtain your Transfer Station permit online. Don't forget that you will need a credit card and email address for these transactions and that a convenience charge will be applied.

How will you know I purchased a permit if I don't have a sticker?

The Transfer Station has new License Plate Recognition Technology. This technology scans your license plate upon arrival at the Transfer Station and indicates to the attendants if the plate is valid (permit purchased) or invalid (permit not purchased). This new technology will help us monitor Transfer Station visits to ensure that only individuals who have purchased permits are using the Transfer Station.

Have the eligibility requirements for the Transfer Station permits changed?

No, eligibility requirements have not been changed for the 2017 season.

Can my renters obtain a Transfer Station permit?

Renters are welcome to purchase a weekly permit via the same methods as residents. They will need to provide their rental agreement to demonstrate that they are, in fact, staying at a Truro address. Please contact the Truro DPW at 508-349-2140 for more information.

How will I know if my online application for a permit was approved?

Upon completing your application online, you will receive an email confirmation that your application was submitted. A second email will notify you if your application was approved and your are ready to visit the Transfer Station or if you are denied and will need to provide more information to obtain your permit.
