The meeting commenced at 6:05 p.m with a quorum. The following agenda was covered:

1. Meeting Minutes of the January 13, 2014 were approved.

2. Public Comments:

a. Chief Takajian submitted contact information for "J1 Hello Summer Organization" as a possible liason to promote bike safety to summer workers.

b. Chief Takajian to keep BWWC notified of progress with State on 8 roads and 4 locations on Route 6 which are to be improved. These areas are to include updated traffic counts.

3. Conflict of Interest Law: attending members of BWWC reviewed and signed.

4. 2014 BWWC Goals and Recommendations: Cathy Haynes to draft 2014 BWWC Recommendations Report for review at next meeting. Additional items to be included are: walkways/hiking locus map, and addition of Massachusetts bike laws and web links to BWWC town website. Recommendations to include contact with other Town Boards and Committees to include bikeways and walkways in their agenda, and to liason with Highway Department and State Highway a minimum of one time per year to review upcoming public works projects that could include bike and walkway improvements.

5. Truro Bike and Walkways Map: Breon Dunigan presented trail/roadway map printed by NPS at January meeting. This map depicts trails, fire roads, and bikeways in the National Park Service lands. Truro Conservation Trust was contacted by Cathy Haynes and they do not have any current mapping which includes hiking paths , but once we have determined our mapping requiremnts, they can provide the TCT property information. Breon Dunigan is to contact Mark Adams to determine if further detailed mapping is available. Cathy Haynes to contact Recreation Department to determine if Truro Hiking/Walking Club has any available information.

6. Cape Cod Regional Bicycle and Pedestrian review. Charleen Greenhaulgh had emailed Cape Cod Commission letter regarding Town Center bikeways. At this time, no revisions or improvements are included for the Saltonstall route through Truro.

7. Old Business:

a. Public Radio Announcements: Karen Snow submitted proposed revisions to PSA's for review. Cathy Haynes to revise. BWWC to submit to local radio stations to utilize as public service announcements in the Spring of 2014.

b. RoadID.com Karen Snow to reviewed website videos and contacted webmaster@Truro-MA.gov for publication. Additional DVD's were obtained by Ms. Snow and will be utilized for Truro TV, school, and possible use by both Provincetown and Wellfleet bike committees.

c. Route 6 Bike Lane Improvements: No new information presented.

d. RMV or Excise Tax Insert: Beach and Recreation Office to include bike safety flyer in mailing.

e. Eagle Neck Culvert: Cathy Haynes contacted Karst Hodgeboom at NPS/CCC to commence discussion of widening Old County Road in area of Eagle Neck culvert construction. No news at this time.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:20 p.m. The next scheduled meeting is March 10, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. at the Truro Safety Facility. Jane Peters, Truro Chamber of Commerce will be a guest at the next meeting.
