Gardner thanks the Community Preservation Committee for supporting the Field Guide to

Truro's Historic Cemeteries which just returned from the printer. A new tour and lecture will be scheduled at the Truro Library for this spring. The fence and sign at the Natural burial area at

Old North is complete. The CPC grant request to repair damaged gravestones remains pending.
