



Please note that there may be a slight delay (approx. 15-30 seconds) between the meeting and the television broadcast/livestream.

Citizens can join the meeting to listen and provide public comment by entering the meeting link; clicking on the agenda's highlighted link; clicking on the meeting date in the Event Calendar; or by calling in toll free. Citizens will be muted upon entering the meeting until the public comment portion of the hearing. If you are joining the meeting while watching the television broadcast/livestream, please lower or mute the volume on your computer or television during public comment so that you may be heard clearly. Citizens may also provide written comment via postal mail or by emailing Liz Sturdy, Planning Department Assistant, at esturdy@truro-ma.gov, one week prior to the meeting, or may instead be addressed during the Public Comment portion of the hearing.




Section 11. Temporary Signs, etc.

The Planning Board may issue permits for temporary signs. Any such permit shall be limited to holiday or special events, and shall be limited to a period of fifteen (15) days, for events lasting one day or two days. For said events having multiple dates such permits shall be limited to a period of thirty (30) days. Not more than four (4) signs shall be erected with respect to any such event. Any such sign shall be firmly attached to a supporting device and shall not present a hazard to the public. Posters intended for window display are exempt from this provision. (4/14)

For multiple 1-2 day events located at the same venue or organization during three consecutive months, the Planning Board will accept a bundled application that includes multiple temporary sign permit applications. (4/18)
