This week's activities of note from the Town Manager's Office:

- Select Board Chair Jan Worthington, Selectperson Maureen Burgess, Chief Jamie Calise and I attended the opening of the 7th year of the Truro Farmer's Market. We wish them great success.
- The Cloverleaf Oversight Committee held a monthly update meeting.
- I attended a conversational session at the Cape Cod Commission for the Rural Policy Plan so that issues unique to Cape Cod rural communities could be discussed and incorporated into the plan.
- The Host Community Agreement negotiating team met to discuss responses from the Co-Op and then had a conference call with Town Counsel.
- Town staff and I met with staff from the Cape Cod National Seashore regarding shorebird protections in the National Seashore.
- Assistant Town Manager Clark and I attended a Mass Works Infrastructure Grant Program Informational Session via conference call. The grant program could potentially be useful in extending the waterline to parts of North Truro.
- I met with my counterparts from Eastham and Wellfleet to discuss our shared challenges, especially those pertaining to beach season getting underway.

Department News:

Police Department

- Members of the Truro Police Department took part in the Massachusetts Special Olympics Cruiser Convoy. This event consisted of over 200 police vehicles from across the state. Those participating met at several locations before convoying together to the 2019 Special Olympics Summer Games at Harvard University where they cheered on the athletes and presented medals. - Truro Police Department is currently accepting applications for full-time Public Safety Telecommunicator. The application period will remain open until the position is filled. More detailed information about the position is posted on the Truro Police Department website.

Department of Public Works

- Beginning July 1, 2019 commercial yard waste will no longer be accepted at the Transfer Station. Residential homeowners can continue to deposit yard waste for free.
- The new lifeguard stand at Head of the Meadow has been installed. Many thanks to Mike Winkler for his help with the move, and Mike Locke for construction.
- Our first load of recycled mattresses and box springs were delivered to Eastham Transfer Station as part of a mattress recycling partnership with Provincetown, Wellfleet, Chatham, and Eastham.

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- A site visit with Eversource to locate potential charging stations for electric cars was conducted at the Community Center and Town Hall. The baseline infrastructure for installation of the charging stations can be paid for with grant funding.
- All DEP grant applications for FY20 have been submitted, awards will be announced this Fall.
- A review of solid waste through June 1, 2019 indicates that solid waste tonnage has dropped 32.96 ton when compared to this time last year. In addition, recycling tonnage has also declined by 19.31 ton when compared to last year.

 - To report a shark sighting please call the Truro Police Department at (508) 487-8730.
 - For inquiries about the beaches please call (508) 487-1632.
 - Warning Recent shark sightings, practice shark safety.
 - Don't swim where seals are present.
 - Don't swim too far from shore.
 - Swim in groups.
 - Avoid wearing shiny jewelry or other accessories (which look like fish scales to a shark).
 - Avoid surfing alone.
 - Avoid areas with signs of baitfish or fish feeding activity watch for diving seabirds.
 - Be aware that sharks may be present between sandbars or near steep drop offs.
