
Town of Truro Town Manager's Weekly Report

Announcements:

- The Governor rolled back the re-opening of Massachusetts to Phase 3 step 1 effective Sunday, December 13th in response to the increasing positive case numbers, and rising hospitalizations. <u>See the Health Agent's report for more</u>.

DPW

- The Transfer Station is closed every Wednesday and Thursday November 1, 2020 through April 30, 2021.
- The opening of the Swap Shop will be evaluated at COVID 19 Reopening Phase 4.
- For the Christmas holiday the Transfer Station will be open on Wednesday December 23, 2020 and closed December 24th and 25th. For the New Year's holiday, the Transfer Station will be open January 1st, 2021, and closed December 30th and 31st.
- Eversource will be in the area for the next few weeks to remove trees and limbs that are a hazard to electrical lines. Eversource has reached out to all abutters including private property owners as well as NPS and the Town for permission to remove trees.
- The DPW FY22 preliminary budget and CIP plan are complete and will be reviewed on December 21st with the Budget Task Force.
- The DPW Director has requested a proposal for engineering services related to waterline and storm water infrastructure to be installed in the Pond Village area. Taskings will include an estimate for permitting, installation, and construction.
- The BSC Engineering Group is developing a proposal for a baseline survey including topography for the Walsh Property. The proposal will also include a structural survey for all buildings, sheds and structures
