- The Outer Cape Towns learned today that they will receive a grant titled "Increasing Coastal Resiliency through Intermunicipal Shoreline Management, Phase 2" in the amount of \$248,470 toward a regional approach to shoreline management for Eastern Cape Cod Bay. The four towns will work to update an intermunicipal geodatabase, explore a potential regional sand stockpiling system, identify parcels suitable for salt marsh migration, inventory low-lying roadways, and continue outreach and education with town staff and community members. Provincetown is the lead Town for this phase. Congratulations to the staff who put this grant together.

Harbor Master/Shellfish Constable

- Harbor Master Jackett baited and set green crab traps to aid predator control which is used as bait for fishermen to catch fish.


- **Fiscal Year 2021** began on July 1, 2020. The Assessor's office is now accepting applications for the FY21 Residential and Statutory Exemptions.
- As a reminder the Residential Exemption DOES NOT have to be renewed annually. We review information and will contact you if clarification is necessary. We accept applications for the Residential Exemption however the program is subject to renewal by an annual vote of the Select Board at the Classification Hearing which will be held virtually September 22, 2020 @ 5pm.
- For Statutory Exemptions (Seniors meeting strict Income and Asset guidelines, Disabled Veterans, and the Blind), we must receive an application annually and supporting documentation must be presented with the application.
- Chapter 61A applications (Parcels totaling >5.0 acres- to be classified as farmland-meeting the requirements for established by the Department of Revenue) for Fiscal Year 2022 are due in the Assessor's office on or prior to October 1, 2020.
- The Deadline for FY21 is April 1, 2021 for exemptions however we advise you return ALL applications early so we can get the exemptions on the October tax bill. Please feel free to contact the Assessor's Office with any questions at 508.349-7004 x 116 and we will be happy to assist.
