


Walsh Property Community Forum

Process Review

- In April, Town meeting voted overwhelmingly to authorize the Board of Selectmen to acquire the 69.9-acre Walsh property. This was approved by voters in May as a Proposition 2 1/2 debt exclusion.
- The use of the Property will be for general municipal purposes. The Board of Selectmen would like to see a combination of uses for the land including; open space, recreation, and housing.
- The specific decisions about how the property will be used will be voted on at a future Town Meeting.

Process Commitment

The Board of Selectmen is hereby authorized and directed to

- create a committee, which
- shall include citizen representatives from diverse sectors of the community. The committee will
- lead a community wide process, beginning in June 2019,
- to engage a wide range of Truro residents in developing plans for the use of the property
- to be presented at a future town meeting for approval.


Quick Facts

- 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 10A, 12, 13 Walsh Way
- One of the last, large undeveloped parcels of land in Truro
- 69.895 acres, including several cottages
- Negotiated purchase price of \$5,100,000.00
- Hire engineer to develop a site plan review
- Board of Selectmen will create a committee, which includes stakeholders/residents, to develop a plan for the use(s) of the land to present at a future Town Meeting for approval.


Updates

- Closing Delayed until Mid August at Seller's Request
- Borrowing Completed – interest rate of 1.5%
- Phase 1 Environmental Assessment Complete – No Recognized Environmental Conditions were found on the site.
- Preliminary Survey under way to create a plan for title insurance.




Town of Truro Assessor's Map

Suggested Ways to Be

- Be Focused – help us stay on track with the agenda

Wishes and Worries about the Use of the Site

- On an index card, write your top Wish on one side, and your top Worry on the other

- First person shares their wish. Partner asks:
 - “Why?”
 - “Why is that important to you?”
 - “What would that accomplish/achieve that you care about?”
- Try to understand what is most important to your partner

Wishes and Worries about the Use of the Site

- Switch roles, repeat
- Then do the same for the worry – first one person, then the second
- Come back to table groups, each partner share the underlying interests and concerns of their partner
- Tables report out
