





- Barrel conversion on Route 6, roundabout at the intersection of Route 6 and Shank Painter Road




612032 Provincetown- Truro-Wellfleet Resurfacing and Related Work on Route 6

- Resurfacing/Asset Management of Route 6
- Exact location of southern project limit being determined
- Evaluating ability to implement limited road diet along Pilgrim Lake section through pavement marking changes




613289 Provincetown- Truro- Route 6 Modernization from Shank Painter Road to Shore Road

- Potential barrel conversion on Route 6 from Shank Painter Road to Route 6 split. Potential roundabouts at 3 intersections
- On-road bicycle accommodations from Route 6 split to Shore Road with pavement marking changes

- Intersection improvements on Route 6




