

Truro Town Clerk Reminds Residents: Return Your Residence Confirmation Cards to Maintain Active Voter Status

The Truro Town Clerk's office is issuing a reminder to all residents who receive a Residence Confirmation Post Card as part of the annual street list process: **These cards must be completed and returned within 10 days of receipt.**

This mailing is mandated by Massachusetts General Law Chapter 51, Section 4C, and is crucial for maintaining accurate voter records.

Importance of Returning Your Card:

For those who did not complete and return their annual street list information, the Residence Confirmation Card is a critical step. Failure to return the attached postcard in a timely manner will result in your name remaining inactive on the voting list.

The Annual Street Listing Census form mailed in January of each year is required to be completed to remain an active Voter.

Per M.G.L. Ch. 51 S. 37A, if a name is made inactive, it will be removed from the voting list if you do not vote in at least one of the next two federal elections or take other action that would reinstate you as an active voter.

How to Return Your Card:

Please complete the Residence Confirmation Card and return it by mail using the provided postage paid postcard.
