From Energy Efficiency to Decarbonization

- Cape Light Compact - Mass Save - shifting focus from energy Efficiency to Decarbonization.
 - Continuing our electrification efforts
 - Encouraging customers to replace existing fossil fuels equipment with high-efficiency heat pumps. Including heating systems, cooking equipment, and water heaters
- As required by the MA Climate Act of 2022, rebates for fossil fuel equipment including gas, oil, and propane furnaces and burners are being phased out.
 - This equipment must have been installed prior to August 31, 2024 and the rebate application submitted by September 30, 2024. Heat Loans are no longer available for fossil fuel equipment.



Heat Loan

- Up to \$25k
 - *effective Jan 1, there is no additional \$25k (\$50k total) for electrification*
- Weatherization, Heat Pumps, Heat Pump Water Heaters, Batteries, Windows, and Barrier Remediation
- 0% interest
- New income-based terms starting July 1, 2025
 - *7-year term for 135% SMI and below*
 - *5-year term for 135% - 300% SMI*
 - *3-year term for 300% and above SMI*
- 2024 Data: 1,312 authorized and 955 closed loans




Small Business Enhancements

Compact Staff Energy Coaching

- Launched in January 2025
- In-person or virtual
- Customers will be able to book time with the Outreach Specialist directly on the website
- Intent will be to help customers:
 - who are unsure where to start
 - who had an energy assessment but are unsure what to do next
 - are having trouble determining which financing or rebate options are right for them
- Should not be used in place of an HEA, calling the call center for general questions or to schedule an HEA, Heating and Cooling consultation

Energy Saver Home Loan

The Energy Saver Home Loan Program will assist homeowners to cut their energy use and reduce or eliminate their reliance on fossil fuels. The Program will provide financing and technical support to households for measures not covered by the Cape Light Compact's energy efficiency program - Mass Save®.



Energy Saver Home Loans will be initiated through Cape Light Compact, and an Energy Service Provider (ESP), Abode Energy Management. The Cape Light Compact will work with participating lenders to assist borrowers through the step-by-step Energy Assessment, Decarbonization Plan, and loan application process.



Income Limits By County

Income levels based on The Department of Housing and Urban Development Median Family Income (MFI). Income qualification is based on names on the property deed, not the income of all residents.



Cape & Vineyard Solar Loan

- Loan from USDA, Rural Utility Service (RUS), Rural Energy Savings Program (RESP), to administer low interest solar financing.
- Total funding of \$4.9 million with \$2.2m in first year.
- Launched December 2, 2024, and received USDA funds December 26th
- **Year One Funds Fully Allocated March 31**
- Loans are serviced by Cape Cod 5 and applications receive a technical review by Self Reliance



Cape & Vineyard Solar Loan

Rate	Term	Loan Amount
2.75%	10 year	Up to \$50k

- Must be a primary year-round residence in Barnstable or Dukes county. Proof of year-round occupancy may be required
 - In year 2 (2026), the loan will open up to small businesses.
- Must be sufficiently weatherized
- Homes in historic districts or under a historic designation, including Old Kings Highway, must provide proof of approval of the installation
- Estimate 50-80 loans in year one. Dependent on the average loan amount. Since funds are limited, loans will be prioritized based on the date of receipt of a complete application.
- Items not related to the PV panels or inverter, such as tree work, roof repair replacement, or batteries will not be covered.





*Public policy on the supply side of the bill includes the costs to power suppliers (like CLC, Eversource Basic Service) of purchasing renewable energy certificates to meet state requirements such as the Renewable Portfolio Standard, the Clean Energy Standard, the Clean Peak Standard, and the Alternative Portfolio Standard

**Public policy on the delivery side of the bill includes the energy efficiency programs, solar programs (SMART and net metering), renewable energy, and electric vehicle programs


