Cape Cod Commission Status Update: Martha Hevenor (Cape Cod Commission) and Lauren McKean (Cape Cod National Seashore) presented three alternatives for the "stem" route from the terminus of the rail trail at LeCount Hollow to Provincetown. Options for branch routes in Truro were reviewed and the committee provided feedback. A revised document for the branch routes will be made available to the committee for further review and comment. The position of the CCNS on the off-road route options in Truro is that the length of the rule making process is prohibitive and that environmentally sensitive, historic, and pre-historic areas would be impacted.

- 5. **Outer Cape Bike and Pedestrian Master Plan status:** The draft letter from BWW to the steering committee on recommendations for the route through Truro will be reviewed at the next meeting.
