Energy Committee Minutes**

July 2, 2020

The Energy Committee held a meeting on July 2, 2020, convened by Nicole Tudor at 8:30a via GoToMeeting. Attending were Brian Boyle (Chair), Mark Farber, Bob Higgins-Steele, Jim Nash, Todd Schwebel, being all the members of the Committee. And members of the public: Jack Reimer.

Cape Light Compact. Bob provided an update of activities of CLC. Brian described the map of Truro solar data that the Committee has constructed, showing the approximately 11% of the Town that now has solar. Brian described discussions regarding augmenting the solar data with home consumption.

Cloverleaf Project. Brian noted that the Committee's activities have been dormant during the pandemic period, but we desire to re-engage with the project. Jim reviewed the Committee's past activities. The Committee discussed a set of recommendations, prepared by Brian and augmented by Jim, and determined next steps for finalizing the recommendations.

Public Comment. Jack Reimer shared his recent personal energy work and supports the work of the Committee, particularly on the Cloverleaf project. He also noted the potential covid impact of central HVAC design.
