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I. INTRODUCTION

Truro's wealth of historic resources from the 18th through 20th centuries is being documented in a multi-phase effort to create a comprehensive Community-wide Historic Properties Survey. The project is under the direction of the Truro Historical Commission (THC) and funded by the Town of Truro Community Preservation Act Program. Following the recommendations from Phases I and II in the *Truro Survey Plan 2010*, Phases III and IV in this Truro Historic Properties Survey 2011, consists of survey, National Register of Historic Places (National Register) eligibility evaluations, and compilation of all existing information into a comprehensive Street Index 2011. The resulting update to the town's Inventory identifies and describes the significant resources in Truro and identifies which of these resources are eligible for the National Register either individually or as part of a district. The Inventory serves as the building block for most of the town's preservation planning goals. This *Truro Historic Properties Survey 2011* report is intended to serve as an overview of and user's guide to the Survey. A comprehensive final summary report of the project, with additional details and data tables, was submitted by PAL (The Public Archaeology Laboratory, Inc.) to the THC along with the Massachusetts Historical Commission (MHC) inventory forms and other accompanying materials.

II. SURVEY OVERVIEW AND METHODOLOGY

Prior to this Survey project, Truro's Inventory on file at the MHC consisted of 395 Forms, including 16 Area Forms. A significant portion of these Forms were written in 1969 and in the 1980s by local volunteers. The remaining Forms were completed by a consultant in 1989. None of the Forms utilized the current MHC format and methodology, and all of the photographs were significantly out of date. This 2011 Survey builds on the results of the *Truro Survey Plan 2010* prepared by historic preservation consultants Eric Dray and Gretchen Schuler, which included a preliminary comprehensive Street Index list of properties to be surveyed within the Town of Truro. The 2011 Survey comprised research, fieldwork, the completion or update of MHC inventory forms, and the evaluation of National Register eligibility for the selected properties identified in the *Survey Plan 2010* and prioritized by the THC for survey update or new survey. The Survey, conducted between October 2010 and August 2011, consisted of archival research, field survey, and evaluation analysis for 306 individual properties and six (6) areas. Four (4) additional areas were also evaluated where the scope called for survey of individual properties in the area, but no changes were made to the area form itself.

Additionally, available information has been incorporated on the survey and National Register nominations initiatives of the National Park Service (NPS) within the Cape Cod National Seashore (CCNHS) for the Dune Shacks Historic District and Mid-Twentieth Century Modern Residential Architecture on Outer Cape Cod, 1929 – 1979, Multiple Property Documentation and Inventory, as well as the Mid-Twentieth Century Modern houses working list prepared by the Cape Cod Modern House Trust (CCMHT). Concurrent projects being conducted for the Town by other consultants to inventory cemeteries and to prepare National Register nominations for Castle Hill and the Hill of Churches are also incorporated into the Community-wide Historic Properties Survey Phases III and IV information.

Individual Properties

A total of 306 MHC Form Bs were completed in the Survey Phases III and IV for submittal to the THC and the MHC. Examples of the three types of form documentation are shown in Appendix A.

New Form Bs

New Form Bs were prepared for the 51 previously undocumented resources (labeled S under the *Street Index 2010* Action column in the attached updated comprehensive *Street Index 2011*). The MHC inventory form includes a cover sheet for each resource, with accurate locational maps, photographs, and assessor's data. Each form contains a complete and current architectural description of the property with information obtained from fieldwork and a historical narrative based on research. A comprehensive list of references is included on each form.

Updated and Expanded Form Bs

Updated and expanded Form Bs were prepared for 66 resources previously recorded in the 1960s and 1980s (labeled U under the *Street Index 2010* Action column in the attached updated comprehensive *Street Index 2011*). The new MHC inventory form includes a cover sheet for each resource, with updated locational maps, photographs, and assessor's data. The form contains an updated and expanded description with information obtained from fieldwork. Existing historical narratives were considered sufficient in Phases I and II, so no additional research on these resources was conducted and no content was added.

Updated Architectural Descriptions, Maps, and Photographs

Updated new Form Bs were prepared for 189 resources previously documented in the late 1980s (labeled Y under the *Street Index 2010* Action column in the attached updated comprehensive *Street Index 2011*). The new MHC inventory form includes a cover sheet for each resource, with updated locational maps, photographs, and assessor's data. The form contains an updated description with information obtained from fieldwork including an assessment of the existing architectural description for each property, based on field observations, noting any changes since the previous survey (e.g., "No visible alterations have been made to the building since it was last surveyed."). Existing historical narratives were considered sufficient in Phases I and II, so no additional research on these resources was conducted and no content was added.

Areas

Six (6) areas identified in the *Truro Survey Plan 2010* and the THC's Request for Proposals were surveyed. They are as follows and are also listed in the attached updated comprehensive *Street Index 2011*:

- Beach Point (368 resources)
- Corn Hill (32 resources)
- Sladeville (11 resources)
- Walsh Way (11 resources)
- 104 Shore Road (a/k/a Young's Camps/Prince of Whales Cottages; 20 resources)
- 95 Shore Road Cottages (6 resources)

Each new MHC inventory form consisted of an Area A cover sheet for each area, with accurate locational maps, photographs, and assessor's data. The form for each area includes a complete architectural description with information obtained from fieldwork and a historical narrative based on research that was conducted for that area. A comprehensive list of references is included on each form, as well as a data sheet listing all the resources included in the area.

III. RESULTS

Inventory Forms

Electronic files and hard copies on archival paper with original photographs of the 306 Form Bs and 6 Area A Forms were submitted to both the THC and the MHC. MHC will add the new forms and the additions/updates to existing forms to the Inventory of the Historic Assets of the Commonwealth files and to their searchable online database, Massachusetts Cultural Resources Information System (MACRIS). In Truro, the forms will be curated at the Truro Public Library. In this way, the comprehensive Community-wide Historic Properties Survey information will be available for use by anyone interested in the historical and architectural heritage of Truro. Additional forms can be added in the future, and forms can be updated as appropriate.

Comprehensive Street Index 2011

In addition to the hard copy provided with this *Truro Historic Properties Survey 2011* report, the comprehensive *Street Index 2011* listing 1377 properties has been provided to the THC as an Excel document. The data can be sorted to generate lists as needed but is provided here in alphabetical order by street address. A second spreadsheet within the Excel file is sorted by MHC Inventory Number to facilitate comparison with the Inventory Map. This Index is comprehensive as of August 2011 but is a working document that should be amended as the THC gathers information. The Comprehensive *Street Index 2011* is in Appendix B.

Inventory Map

A large-scale Inventory Map prepared as part of the Survey identifies all inventoried properties and areas (labeled with MHC Inventory Number) and a three-part 11x17-inch reproducible map set. The Excel spreadsheet organized by MHC Inventory Number can be used to identify each property and area on the map. A section of the map is reproduced here.

Survey Eligibility Recommendations

As a result of the field survey, research, and National Register eligibility evaluations conducted in Phases III and IV, 54 individual properties and eight (8) historic districts (4 of the 6 newly surveyed areas and 4 previously surveyed areas) with 545 contributing properties included in the comprehensive Truro Historic Survey are recommended as National Register eligible, based on the information available at this time. Other resources, particularly among the Mid-Twentieth Century Modern properties, will be identified as eligible for National Register listing in future as more research becomes available and with the passage of time.

National Register Criteria Statements attached to the associated building B or area A Inventory Form describe the criteria and areas of significance under which the resource is considered to be eligible for listing. The historic contexts identified in the *Truro Survey Plan 2010*, which span periods of time from pre-history to the present, were used to evaluate the historical significance of Truro's resources under Criterion A. In recommending properties eligible under Criterion C as good examples of a particular architectural type, style, or period, the evaluators considered the entire collection of such resources within Truro and identified the best-preserved examples within each category. No properties were evaluated in this round as meeting National Register Criterion B, for association with an important person, or Criterion D, for information that it may contain important in history or prehistory.

Applicable Historic Contexts

- **Native Patterns and Colonial Explorations (Pre-history to 1650):** Prior to the first colonial explorations in the seventeenth century, Truro was the site of several native settlements, represented by the Corn Hill Area.
- **Colonial Settlements (1650-1790):** Modest resources survive from the early permanent colonial settlements of the late seventeenth through the eighteenth centuries, including the ca. 1719 Richard Paine House at 1 Higgins Hollow Road and the ca. 1727-1730 Rich-Cobb House at 84 Prince Valley Road, as well as clusters of houses in the Longnook/Higgins Hollow and Pamets areas.
- **Maritime Boom Years (1790-1860):** Many houses and institutional buildings survive from Truro's early to mid-nineteenth-century maritime boom, such as the Hughes McKinnon House at 21 Whitmanville Road (ca. 1790-1800), the John Francis/Ruth Hopkins House on Atwood Road (ca. 1830-1850), and the former North Truro Primary-Grammar School at 52 Shore Road (ca. 1852). The Depot Road and Pond Village/North Truro areas also developed during this period.
- **Transition from Maritime Industry to Tourism (1860-1890):** A few well-preserved examples of residential architecture from the town's late nineteenth-century shift from maritime industry to tourism remain extant, including the ambitious ca. 1880-1890 Captain Atkins Hughes House at 11 Hughes Road and the modest J.E. Roger Barber House at 18 Pond Road, built ca. 1875-1890. The Pond Village Cold Storage Fish House Buildings are a rare reminder of the evolution of Truro's fishing industry, before it largely disappeared to be replaced by the twentieth-century tourism boom.
- **Tourism Boom Years (1890-1960), including cottage colonies and artist/writer communities:** The Beach Point, Corn Hill, Sladeville, and Young's Camps/Prince of Whales Cottages are all associated with Truro's development into a resort town that began with small vacation complexes and cottage colonies. By the 1930s, many artists and writers arrived to live and work amid the town's dramatic natural landscapes. Some built new houses, like the Edward Hopper House at 31 Stephens Way (ca. 1930); while others moved into historic houses, like Henry Varnum Poor who bought the ca. 1830 Perez Bangs House on Phats Valley Road.

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- **Consolidation of Truro as Summer Destination (1960 to Today):** Truro's Mid-Twentieth Century Modern resources that are in the process of being surveyed and evaluated illustrate this phase of the Town's development, including the Serge Chermayeff House and Studio on Black Pond Road and the Charles Jencks House on Slough Pond Road.



V. FURTHER STUDY RECOMMENDATIONS

The following recommendations for further study are offered at the conclusion of Phases II and IV of the comprehensive Truro Historic Survey project:

1. **Street Index 2011.** The accompanying *Street Index 2011* Excel spreadsheet of Truro's inventoried historic resources is a valuable research tool and can be posted online for wide access from the Town's website. It can also be used as the starting point for a future searchable electronic database using a program such as Microsoft Access or a Geographic Information System program.
2. **Inventory Forms – electronic PDFs.** The PDFs of existing inventory forms that are currently available from the MHC's online MACRIS database can be integrated with the new updated inventory forms produced in this project. The complete forms can then be linked by hyperlinks added to the *Street Index 2011* Excel spreadsheet.
3. **Inventory Forms – paper copies.** Paper copies of the complete set of inventory forms can be made from the PDFs to be bound and distributed to other Town offices and libraries for further public access. Copies of individual building forms can also be mailed to current owners.
4. **Planning Integration.** The results of this survey update should be integrated into any municipal master planning process and documents.

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5. **National Register Nominations.** The Town can consider pursuing the nomination of the eight (8) areas and 54 individual properties identified as eligible for listing in the National Register.
 6. **Additional Survey.** The current survey is comprehensive as of 2011, as defined in the *Truro Survey Plan 2010*. In the future, as more properties reach 50 years of age, and as additional funds become available, survey of the areas identified in the Plan but not included in the Phases I and II recommended scope of work for Phases III and IV should be completed and existing Area forms should be expanded as recommended in the *Truro Survey Plan 2010*. These areas are as follows:
 - Pond Village/North Truro (TRU.B)
 - Longnook/Higgins Hollow (TRU.C)
 - South Truro (TRU.F)
 - Depot Road/Pamet Harbor (TRU.G)
 - Truro Center (TRU.H)
 - The Pamets (TRU.I)
 - Whitmanville – Great Hollow (TRU.K)
 - Hogs Back – Fisher Beach (TRU.P)
 7. **Mid 20th-Century Modern Resources.** The *Truro Survey Plan 2010* recommended that the THC work with the CCMHT and the CCNS/NPS to identify responsibility for the documentation of Truro's Mid-Twentieth Century Modern resources. The NPS undertook a survey and National Register project, completed by PAL, in 2010-2011. The survey included 48 Modern residential properties located within the boundaries of the CCNS in Eastham, Wellfleet, Truro, and Provincetown. The list of properties included in the survey was compiled by the NPS and the CCMHT, and only NPS-owned properties were evaluated for National Register eligibility. Of the nine properties in Truro that were surveyed, two NPS-owned properties were evaluated for National Register listing and recommended not eligible, and seven privately owned properties were inventoried but not evaluated. These properties are included in the *Street Index 2011*. They have not yet been entered into the MHC database. The major work product for this project was a *Mid-Twentieth-Century Modern Residential Architecture on Outer Cape Cod, 1929-1979 National Register Multiple Property Documentation Form (MPDF)* as well as individual National Register nomination forms for six NPS-owned properties in Wellfleet. To increase understanding and awareness of Mid-Twentieth Century Modern resources in Truro, the THC should consider evaluating the seven privately owned Modern properties that were surveyed and adding the Modern resources in Truro that are outside the CCNS to the comprehensive survey. Properties in Truro that are found eligible for National Register listing could be added to the MPDF in the future.

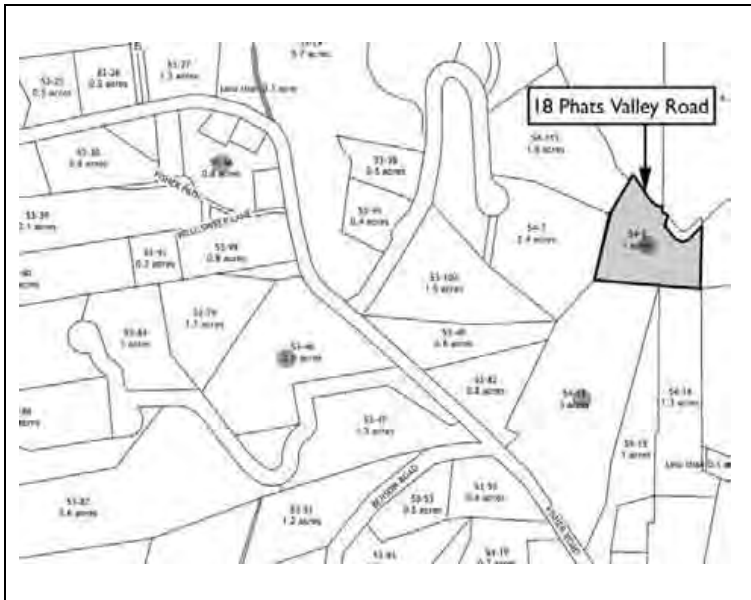

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ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION

The Perez Bangs House at 18 Phats Valley Road is a one-story wood-frame house originally built ca. 1830. The Greek Revival-style building has an end-gable form, three bays long by two bays deep, and faces north toward the Pamet River marshes. A one-story gable-roofed ell with gabled dormers extends perpendicular to the house from the west elevation. A small wood-frame shed is located in the trees to the north of the house.

The house has an asphalt-shingled roof with a small brick chimney at the center of the roof ridge. A second brick chimney rises from the ridge of the ell. The facade (north) elevations of the house and ell have clapboard siding, and the remaining elevations are clad in unpainted wood shingles. The house sits on a brick foundation. It retains its characteristic Greek Revival trim, including wide corner pilasters, a wide molded entablature along the side elevations, and deep eave returns at the gable ends. The main entrance is located in the western bay of the facade, where a simple rectangular door flanked by multi-pane sidelights is set within a wide molded surround with a heavy entablature. A secondary entrance with a simpler flat board surround is located in the center of the side ell's facade. Fenestration consists of six-over-six double-hung wood sash in regularly spaced, rectangular openings with simple molded wood surrounds. The windows on the north elevation all have louvered shutters. A single square four-pane window is centered under the roof in the north gable end.

The house appears to have had very few exterior alterations since its construction and is in very good condition. It is a well-preserved example of the Greek Revival end-gable house that gained popularity in New England in the first half of the 19th century, although far fewer houses of this type were built in Truro than in other towns in the region.

HISTORICAL NARRATIVE

The house at 18 Phats Valley Road appears to have been built ca. 1830 by Perez Bangs (1762-1834). Bangs (possibly a descendant of Edward Bangs of Wellfleet) married Thankful Rich Lombard (1763-1845) in Truro in February 1786. Their son Perez, Jr. (b. 1793), married Deborah Hatch in 1816. Deed research shows that Bangs, Sr., together with Thomas Hatch, purchased woodland south of the Pamet River from Jonathan Harding in January 1825 for \$55. Five years later, Bangs, Sr., sold a swath of "land and swamp" adjacent to his own dwelling house to his son Paul for \$30. These records indicate that Bangs, Sr., constructed a house on his property between 1825 and 1830.

After Bangs, Sr.'s death, his children transferred his homestead, containing "an orchard, dwelling house and other buildings on an estimated 10 acres" to Asa C. Paine, Jr. Paul L. Bangs sold another property to George Kelley around the same time. The property changed hands and was subdivided many times throughout the 19th and early 20th centuries, although the house built ca. 1830 remained relatively unaltered. It belonged to the Grove family from 1871 through 1923 and appears on the 1880 Walker map of the area as the property of James A. Grove.

In 1923, Henry H. Dauphinee purchased the house from Sarah A. Grove. During Dauphinee's ownership, the internationally known artist Edward Hopper, who lived nearby in South Truro (31 Stephen's Way, TRU.126), often sketched and painted the picturesque house standing alone amid the surrounding rolling hills. It appears in the 1931 watercolor *Captain Kelly's House*, the 1932 oil painting titled *Dauphinee House*, and the 1932 watercolor *Railroad Embankment*. As the latter title suggests, Hopper's images also show the railroad tracks passing directly in front of the house. Notes on one of Hopper's sketches refer to the "cerulean shutters closed," a "white stone hitching post," and the "House closed up and for sale."

Hopper's friend and fellow artist, Henry Varnum Poor (1888-1970), eventually purchased the house from Dauphinee in 1946. Poor and his wife Bessie owned the house through 1960, when Peter and Ann Poor (presumably the son and daughter-in-law of Henry and Bessie) purchased it. The younger Poors sold it to Harold C. and Jane M. Field in 1969. Harold was an editor at *Time Life* magazine and spent some time researching the history of the house. The Fields eventually divorced, and the house remains in Jane Field's ownership.

The Perez Bangs House at 18 Phats Valley Road is recommended as eligible for individual listing in the National Register under Criteria A and C at the local level in the areas of Social History and Architecture. Under Criterion A, the building possesses significance for its associations with both Truro's development as an important New England maritime center in the 19th century and the town's early to mid-20th-century artistic and cultural milieu. The house was built ca. 1830, during a period of prosperity and growth in Truro related to the maritime industries. In 1946, the American painter, sculptor, potter, and self-taught architect Henry Varnum Poor (1887-1970) purchased the house, joining a vibrant community of artists and writers living in Provincetown, Truro, and Wellfleet. Poor, well-known for his large-scale murals installed in numerous government buildings, had vacationed at Wellfleet's Mayo Hills Colony Club, or "The Colony," a resort frequented by many other artists. In Truro, summer ateliers tended to be found dispersed across the town in scenic locations. Poor likely knew of the picturesque house on Phats Valley Road through the images produced of it by his friend and fellow artist Edward Hopper, who lived nearby in South Truro, in the 1930s. The house is also significant under Criterion C as an excellent example of the typical Greek Revival-style end-gable house with a side ell built in Truro in small numbers during the first half of the 19th century. It retains its characteristic wide corner pilasters, wide molded entablature, and deep eave returns, as well as the original wide molded door surround with a heavy entablature and multi-pane sidelights.

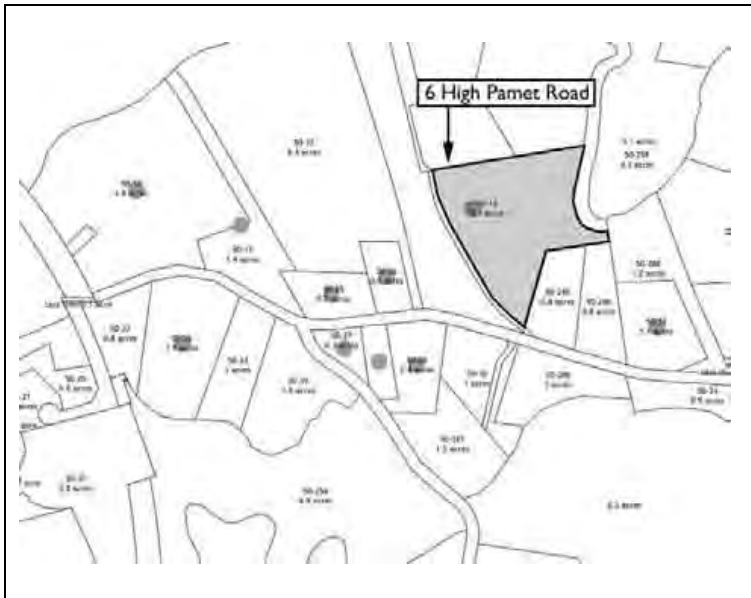

ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION

The Benjamin Collins House at 6 High Pamet Road is a two-story wood-frame structure with a shallow hip roof built ca. 1830. The Federal-style house is five bays long by two bays deep and is oriented perpendicular to High Pamet Road, facing south. The building has a one-story addition on the north elevation. A dirt driveway leads east of the house to a small gable-roofed shed. The 1980 inventory form describes the outbuilding as a one-room cottage.

The building has an asphalt-shingled roof with a large brick center chimney at the roof ridge. The walls are clad in wood shingles with narrow wood corner boards. The small outbuilding is also clad in wood shingles. The main entrance in the center bay of the south elevation retains its characteristic Federal-style heavy wood door surround with a fanlight, sidelights, wide pilasters, and a wide lintel. The fenestration consists of regularly arranged, rectangular, wood, double-hung windows with simple wood surrounds, in a combination of twelve-over-six and six-over-six sash.

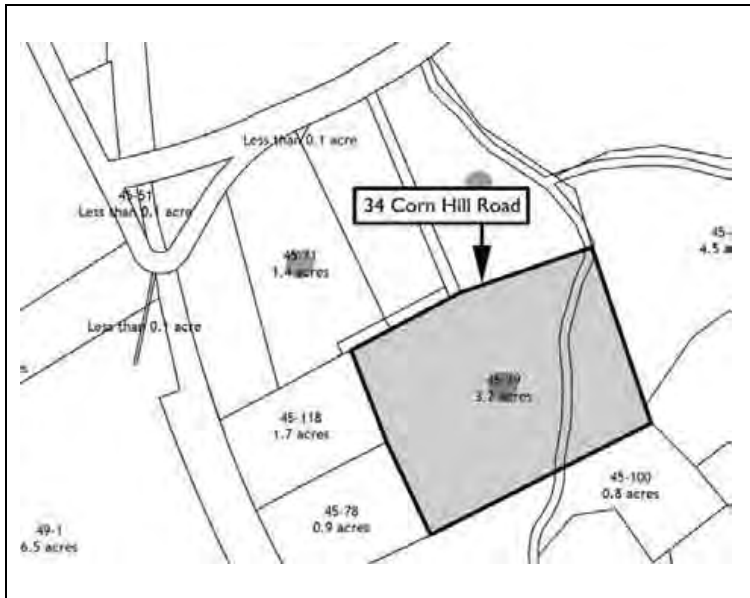

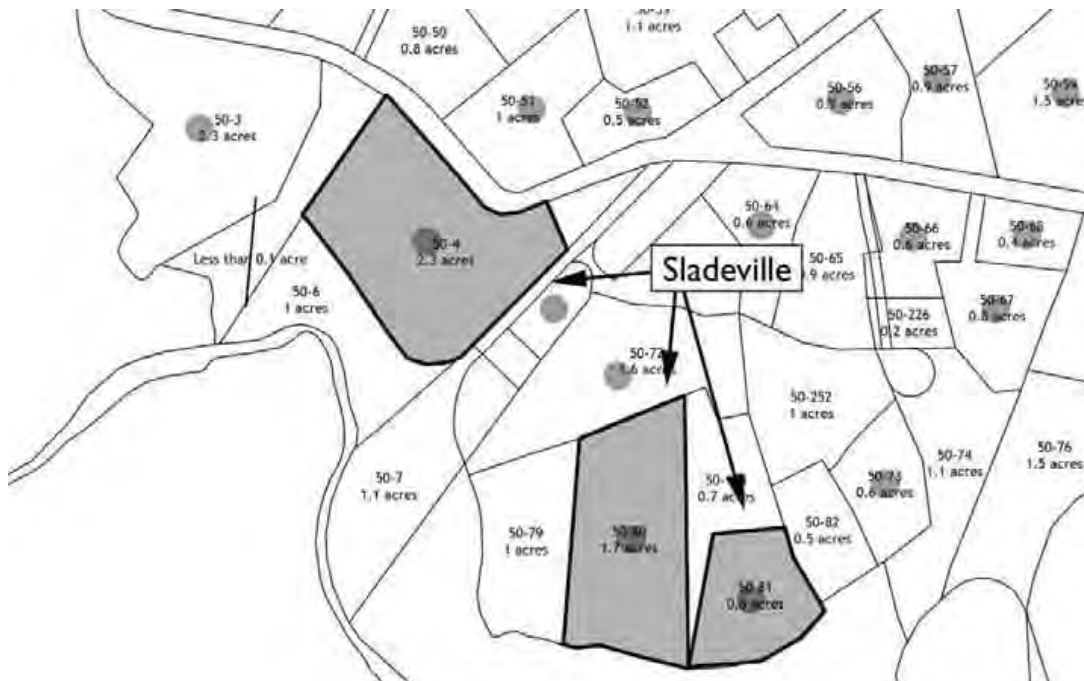

METHODOLOGY

The methodology for each column is provided below:

STREET #

The street number, part of the street address, has been derived in the field or from assessor's maps and records if not seen on the property.

STREET NAME

The street name is the name in Assessor's database, which does not always conform to street name on Assessor map or in the field.

There were no street addresses connected to the 395 Inventory Forms. As part of their work, the consultants identified the appropriate address for each Form.

INV #

The inventory number is the number that has or will be assigned by the MHC and will be the unique property number that is incorporated into the MHC data base after completion of the survey. The MHC inventory numbers for the 395 properties that have been documented to date are included as well as the inventory letters for the 16 Area Forms. In many towns, the MHC has overridden the town's Inventory numbering resulting in two numbers for each property. To provide clarity in Truro, the first column provides the Inventory number originally assigned by the town. "" indicates that there is no corresponding Local Form #. If a letter follows the Inventory # that refers to the Area within which the resource falls. The list of Areas is provided at the end of the Street Index.

MHC #

This column provides the Inventory number assigned by the MHC and officially used in the MHC database MACRIS (Massachusetts Cultural Resource Information System). This is the number that should be used moving forward. The MHC will provide survey numbers for future work. If a capitalized letter is found after a Local# or MHC#, it refers to an Area Form within which the property is located. A list of Areas is found at the beginning of the Street Index.

YEAR

The year indicates the time in which the resource was constructed. The date is generated from the Assessor database. For those resources which have been surveyed, the recorded date, or range of dates, is included with an "(S)", followed by the year provided in the Assessor database. The few dates followed by "(ED)" indicate buildings where there was no date in the Assessor data base and the consultant provided the estimate, those followed by "(MHT)" indicate that the date came from the Cape Cod Modern House Trust. In many cases, research conducted for a Survey will lead to a significant adjustment from the date found on the Assessor list.

HISTORIC NAME

The historic name refers to the first known person or use to be associated with a property, derived from map research or existing Survey forms.

COMMON NAME OR DESCRIPTIVE NOTES

This column contains any common name associated with the property. In a few cases, this column also includes observations, questions or clarifications pertaining to the resource and/or the existing Inventory Form. "CCNS" means the property falls within and is owned by the Cape Cod National Seashore or other federal entity. "CCMHT" means the information on the property came from the Cape Cod Modern House Trust; some of these properties have no known locational information. Finally, this column notes if a surveyed building has since been demolished.

STYLE/Form

Style/Form indicates an architectural style or building form that was recorded during the windshield survey or that was already recorded on an existing survey form. This column also includes descriptive information such as number of stories and roof shape. "Cottage" is used to denote the vernacular buildings. The information in this column may be refined as properties are examined more carefully.

This column also notes whether the resource appears to have been altered, meaning significant changes to both materials and form; whether there are additions which do not appear to be original to the building's construction; and whether the building has been rehabilitated, meaning retention of essential form but replacement of many original materials. Finally, this column notes whether there are any significant outbuildings, such as barns, garages, cottages or sheds.

MAP/PARCEL/EXT

The Truro Assessors number includes the Map, Parcel and Extension number. It is an important piece of information as it is the unique identifying feature of a property, and will be the key to including historic resource information in the town's GIS mapping program. Truro, with the assistance of the Cape Cod Commission, has adopted the Geographic Information System (GIS). The Street Index included in this Survey Plan can be mapped electronically using the Assessors Parcel numbers to produce a map that shows the locations of resources already documented on survey forms and those recommended for documentation.

ACTION

This final column provides an analysis of what actions should be taken moving forward.

"NR" means the resource is already being studied for listing on the National register.

"Y" indicates that an existing Form is adequate in architectural description and historical narrative but a new Form B should be prepared to current standards including new photo, map and other information.

"U" indicates that an existing Form is inadequate in terms of architectural description and/or historical narrative and further work is required to bring to current standards.

"S" means that a currently undocumented resource should be surveyed.

"(Area)" means that the resource should only be recorded as part of an Area Form.

FINAL NOTE

Following completion of this Street Index, MHC conducted a thorough examination of their records and GIS information and provided a revised list of MHC and Local Survey numbers. These are the final decision on numbering (which MHC has redone in part) and has, therefore, been used to revise this Street Index. However, the dates from this Street Index appear to be more accurate; the new MHC dates were not added, but are available on their separate database.

Added to Key 2011:

"ACTION" column changed to "2010 ACTION"

Shading indicates that resource was surveyed by PAL in 2010-2011.

NR STATUS

This column indicates the current (August 2011) status of the property relative to the National Register of Historic Places.

NR listed - Previously listed in the National Register.

NR DOE - Determined eligible by the Keeper for listing in the National Register.

Pending - National Register individual nomination prepared and being processed.

Pending district - National Register district nomination prepared and being processed.

In pending district - Individual property within a pending National Register district.

NR eligible - Evaluated and recommended as National Register eligible.

In eligible area - Individual property within a survey area that is recommended as National Register eligible.
