**Milling and overlay of the roadway, installing pavement markings for bicycle lanes and signage along Route 6 in the Town of Truro from South Highland Road to Shore Road. In addition, improvements are proposed at the Route 6/Shore Road intersection including modification of the crossing. Also, the Route 6 pavement markings will be reconfigured between Shore Road and South Hollow Road, moving the 2 to 4 lane shift cross section closer to South Hollow Road located to the North.**

**Bicycle accommodations consisting of a bicycle lane have been provided in accordance with applicable design guides.**

Bicycle accommodations consisting of a 5’ minimum bicycle lane have been provided in accordance with applicable design guides.

Plans will be on display one-half hour before the meeting begins, with an engineer in attendance to answer questions regarding this project.
