## PRESS RELEASE

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: May 25, 2021

Town offices remain open with virtual, remote, and online services, and on June 4th will begin offering limited in-person public services at Town Hall on Fridays from 12:00pm-4:00pm and Mondays from 8:00am-12:00pm.

Masks and physical distancing will continue to be required inside all public buildings for staff and the public per the revised order of the Board of Health until at least July 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Town Hall, 24 Town Hall Rd:** Town Hall will offer in-person services to the public for Town business Friday afternoons (12:00pm-4:00pm) and Monday mornings (8:00am-12:00pm). Town services will continue to be accessible online, by phone, by appointment. These "virtual services" include online permitting and payments for Transfer Station and beach access. The drop box located outside of Town Hall will be available at all hours for depositing applications, forms, and non-cash payments. The public is encouraged to continue to utilize "virtual" services and make appointments for pick-ups and meetings.

**Public Library, 7 Standish Way:** Starting June 1st, the Library will offer both in-person and curbside services using our Covid-adjusted schedule. Our current hours will be Monday 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.; Tuesday 2 p.m. to 6 p.m.; Wednesday 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.; Thursday 2 p.m. to 6 p.m.; Friday 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.; and Saturday 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. For now the meeting rooms and our lower level will not be open. Items may still be requested through the CLAMS catalog on the library website www.trurolibrary.org. Programs will be outside if weather permits and virtual if not. **COA**, and Recreation, 7 Standish Way: Beginning June 1st, the COA will offer one-onone outreach appointments on site, during the hours of 8:00am-12:00pm on Mondays and on Fridays from 12:00pm-4:00pm. Virtual programming will be offered throughout the month of June. Medical rides will still be provided Monday and Thursdays within Barnstable County. Mail and food deliveries are still available Tuesday and Fridays.

In addition to 6 feet of physical distancing, all public must be masked upon entering any Town Building, the Transfer Station or the entrances/exits of Town beaches, and while attending the Annual Town Meeting. The Town will continue to assess the public health environment and make recommendations for changes to public access to Town facilities prior to July 1<sup>st</sup>.
