**3. Discussion with Jarrod Cabral, DPW:**

- a. **Possible use of recycling glass using haulers to remove it-** found to not a viable option compared to cost.
- b. **Is there really a need for background checks for potential swap shop volunteers-**Must be done there is no choice on the matter.
- c. **Increasing swap shop days and hours to those of the transfer station-** Cannot not be changed.
- d. **Open swap shop to people from other towns-**not eligible for those without a town dump sticker.
- e. **Update on new Swap shop structure and timeline of demolition of old and remediation of site-** Starting October the swap shop will be closed and demolished. Still reviewing numbers for wood prefab shed and metal shipping container.
