1. Call to Order: Terri Humes called the meeting to order at 5:16 PM.

2. Approval of Minutes: Tim Dickey presented a motion to approve the minutes of May 23, September 25, 2018 second by Michelle Jarusiewicz, vote 1-0-2 Michelle Jarusiewicz and Tim Dickey abstained.
