**4. Administrator's Reports:**

- **Superintendent Mike Gradone Report:**

- Mike has met with various boards and Dep't heads to discuss issues such as tennis courts, summer overflow parking for beaches and affordable housing.
- Mike and Bob will meet with Nauset Middle School Admin. to discuss orientation options for incoming Truro 7<sup>th</sup> graders.
- Contract negotiations have gone very smoothly and are complete.

- **Principal Bob Beaudet Report:**

- Enrollment – Oct. 1, 2015 - Total # of students is 119, largest class is 4<sup>th</sup> grade with 19 students.
- Professional development on Oct. 9 – a.m. focus was iPad training with Kathy Schrock, p.m. focus was literacy program, looking at assessment data and establishing routines.
- Evaluations for staff will be compiled using Teach Point system, web based program with all data in one place, easily accessible by staff and administration.

- Special Ed Dept. finalizing schedules, collaborating with Bob on social/emotional development and exploring a framework for whole school behavior support which will complement Responsive Classroom.
