1. Call to Order: Vida Richter called the meeting to order at 4:31 PM.

5. Administrator's Reports:

5.1 Superintendent - Superintendent Costigan introduced the updated TCS 23 - 24 Employee Handbook. Updates include the approved Code of Conduct, the district strategy and reformatting. Superintendent Costigan reported the 25 doors due to be replaced this summer has been delayed. Weston and Sampson will be conducting a site visit and inspection of the HVAC system the week of August 28, 2023. The TCS fire panel and air horns have failed and are being replaced. The new fire panel was purchased with FY23 funds. The unexpected labor costs for the installation is estimated at \$4,000. and will be funded out of the building maintenance line. The gym floor is undergoing yearly maintenance, there is damage from pickleball tape which will increase the cost of labor to repair. Ms. Harper and Superintendent Costigan are discussing a 3 year maintenance plan which will include repainting the basketball lines and adding dashed lines for pickleball. After school program options being discussed with Darren Tangemann, Kelly Clark, Damion Clemons and Kim Jennings from the vendor AlphaBest. The town will be advertising the newly approved positions and AlphaBest will submit a proposal. Superintendent Costigan is hopeful that an after school program will be established by October.

5.2 Principal - Principal Riley reported staff will be in the building Aug. 29, 30 and 31st. Grades 1 - 5 first day is Sept. 5, PK and K first day is Sept. 7. The student handbooks have been updated, the overall format is the same as last year. Arrival and dismissal of students has been updated. The buddy classroom for consequences has been removed from behavior protocols. There is an active posting for an ELL teacher. Interviews are scheduled. Art teacher Kim Possee has retired. Science teacher Stacey Klimkosky will be the Science/Art teacher. TCS Facebook and Instagram accounts are up and running.
