Lower Cape Development Corp presentation for potential funding of shellfish grants – Ann Robinson made a verbal presentation on Lower Cape Community Development Corp and the grants, funding and help that that could be available for affordable housing, business counseling, ground fisherman and shellfish loans. Further discussion continued on potential grants for thing that could specifically help the commercial shellfish efforts in Truro and P-town with the possibility of grant to purchase a salt water ice make for shellfish and ground fish. Further discussion included how this could happen as far as grant writing, mutual aid between Truro & P-Town to share the resource, and timing. TBC for next SAC meeting.
