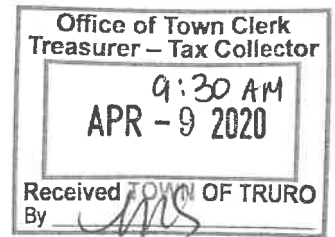
8. New Business:

8.1 April Vacation - Some districts in Massachusetts are continuing to have teachers work online with students right through the scheduled April vacation. Others are treating it as a vacation week, and resuming online learning support on April 27. The Cape and Islands Superintendents have discussed it during our weekly online meetings, and we on the Outer Cape (Truro, Provincetown, Nauset and Monomoy) have agreed to treat it as a vacation. While there are two legitimate perspectives, our preference is to give children and teachers a break from a very intense month's activities; stay together, especially in cases where a family has children in two districts; and hope we instead get time in person with our students at the end of the year.

No vote is necessary, but setting the calendar is the Committee's prerogative, so it is included on the agenda, should the Committee wish to take a vote.

8.2 Consider Student Opportunity Act Plan - The formal plan will be sent to Committee members by Monday, April 13. The substance of the plan is as described in March: three objectives, including Pre-school, Early Literacy, and a Writing program aligned with the state Frameworks. There is a budget component which assigns previously-budgeted sums (teacher salaries, or professional development) to these objectives. Once those have been determined, the final draft will be sent along. A vote to approve the plan is recommended.

8.3 Superintendent's Evaluation 2019-20 - The Committee may discuss whether to move ahead with the process, or defer to a later date.
