EXECUTIVE SESSION

This will be an in-person meeting. The meeting will begin in open session solely for the purpose of moving, as set forth below, to enter into executive session. The meeting will be closed to the public once the Board votes to enter into Executive Session.

Move that the Select Board enter into Executive Session in accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 30A, §21 (a) 3 to discuss strategy with respect to collective bargaining or litigation if an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the bargaining or litigating position of the public body, Truro Permanent Firefighters, (and the Chair so declares it) and;

Move that the Select Board enter into Executive Session in accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 30A, §21 (a) 1 to discuss the reputation, character, rather than professional competence, of an individual, or to discuss the discipline or dismissal of, or complaints or charges brought against, a public officer, employee, staff member or individual; review and vote to release or hold meeting minutes and not to reconvene in open session, unless the individual involved requests that the session be open.
