Re: South Highland Road Data

- 35 Homes directly abut South Highland Road between the Route 6 intersection at South Highland Road and Dew line Road.
- 9 private road curb cuts directly abut South Highland Road between the Route 6 intersection at South Highland Road and Dew Line Road. These private road curb cuts serve smaller neighborhood homes in the South Highland Road area.
- The east portion of South Hollow Road serves 3 residential structures, 1 commercial structure, and accesses South Highland Road 600' south of Dew Line Road.
- South Highland Road provides access to Coast Guard Beach, Highland Links Golf Course, Highland Museum, Payomet Performing Arts Center, Horton's Campground, and the National Park Service.

Due to the housing density and 9 private road curb cuts between the Route 6 and South Highland Road intersection and Dew Line Road I recommend moving any signage related to the commercial facilities on South Highland Road farther south directing vehicle traffic onto South Hollow Rd.

Sincerely, Jarrod J. Cabral Director Department of public works In 2017 a speed & traffic study was completed, data demonstrated that a speed reduction was warranted. Speed was reduced to 35 MPH on the South area of South Highland Road, and 15 MPH on the most northern section of South Highland.

The Building Department shows on record that there have been 5 new homes built in the South Highland Road area. The RTA, Highland Museum, Payomet, the Highland Golf course, and the campground all operated while the previous study in 2017 was being done.

The South Highland Roadway neighborhood area consists of 20 roads of the 20 roads South Highland Road, Highland Road, Aldridge Road and So Hollow Road have direct access from Route 6 and intersect with South Highland Road.

The south portion of South Highland Road has 5 roads that intersect with South Highland while the northern section also has 5 roads that intersect with South Highland Road all of which were present during the last speed and traffic study.

Another speed and Traffic study was completed in the summer of 2023, the data collected did not support a speed reduction.

The Planning Board has stated that signs will no longer be permitted for installation to the immediate South of the South Highland Road and Route 6 intersection – Planning Board approved in Fall of 2023.

The following traffic calming measures have been implemented.

- Warning signs to lower speed have been installed on both the north and south ends of South Highland Road.
- "Warning stop ahead" sign has been installed prior to the Route 6 intersection.
- Double yellow lines have been installed to narrow the roadway to naturally slow vehicles.
- Radar sign indicating YOUR SPEED has been installed with an advisory speed sign (25MPH).
- Three "Warning crossroad" symbolic signs have been installed between the Route 6 / South Highland Road intersection and Dewline Road with 25 MPH speed advisory signs on the same sign post.
- Fog lines will be installed this spring/summer to narrow the road lanes to 11' in width. The fog lines will be accompanied by a "Road Narrows" sign with a 25 MPH speed advisory sign.

Since the RTA has stated that there is high ridership in that area I recommend installing two crosswalks.

One crosswalk to be located at Moses Way and South Highland Road and another at Alden Circle and South Highland.
