

Truro Planning Board Notice of Remote Public Hearing

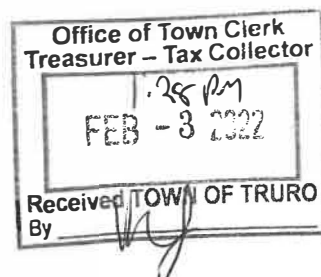
On Wednesday, March 2, 2022 at 5:00 pm the Truro Planning Board will hold a remote public hearing on the matters below. The Town of Truro Planning Board will hold a public hearing pursuant to G.L. c.40A regarding proposed amendments to the following sections of the Town of Truro Zoning Bylaws: to amend the "Purpose" section of the Bylaw (§10.2), and to amend the definition of the term "Street" as appearing in §10.4. The Board will formulate a report to Town Meeting with recommendations as to whether the members favor or oppose the proposed amendments.

MARCH 2, 2022 – PUBLIC HEARING

The Town of Truro Planning Board will hold a public hearing pursuant to G.L. c.40A regarding proposed amendments to the following sections of the Town of Truro Zoning Bylaws:

Section 10.2 Purpose – to add language: promote carbon sequestration by natural means, promote the use of Green Energy and Green building practices, protect native soils from unnecessary removal or disturbance, and protect and maintain the scenic rural character, ambiance, and aesthetics of Truro.

Section 10.4 Street Definition – insert the language from 1989 design standards referenced and add language including streets in approved subdivisions as providing frontage.
