



## 2021 TRURO TOWN MEETING INFORMATION

*Guidance for a safe and comfortable Town Meeting for all citizens.*

### DATE, TIME & PLACE

**DATE & TIME:** Saturday, June 26, 2021 at 10 AM  
**CHECK-IN:** Starts at 9 AM  
**LOCATION:** Truro Central School Ballfield, 317 Rt 6  
**RAIN DATE:** Sunday, June 27, 2021 at 10 AM

### HEALTH & SAFETY

**MASKS:** A mask/face covering must be worn at all times (unless medically unable).  
**DISTANCE:** Maintain 6 feet from others (except those in your household).  
**MICROPHONES:** Sanitized frequently; keep mask on when speaking.  
**TENT:** A respite tent will offer temporary protection from the sun/weather.  
**SEATING:** Seats will be in pairs and singles; household members may sit together.  
**HAND SANITIZER:** Sanitizer will be available; voters may bring their own.

### ENTRY, MEETING, & EXIT

**ENTRY:** Form a physically-distanced line at entry of ballfield.  
**CHECK-IN:** When invited by greeter, approach check-in station to receive voter card.  
**ENTER FIELD:** Proceed to single field entrance as directed, maintaining distance, and following all directional signs.  
**SEATING:** A greeter will guide you to a seat. PLEASE DO NOT MOVE CHAIRS!  
**MICROPHONES:** Stationary microphones available or, if needed, one can be brought to you.  
**DEPARTURE:** Voters will leave one section at a time; please wait for guidance.

### CHANGES TO IMPROVE SAFETY

**QUORUM:** There is no reduced quorum this year.  
**VOTING:** Voters will receive voter cards.  
**CHECK-IN:** Two check in tables will be available for your convenience.

### AMENITIES

**PARKING:** Use lower parking lot. Overflow on Route 6.  
**BATHROOMS:** Port-a-potties will be available on the field.  
**FOOD/DRINKS:** Not available.  
**TRANSPORTATION:** Not available.  
**CHILD CARE:** Not available.  
**SKIN PROTECTION:** Insect repellent wipes and sunscreen wipes will be available.

### SPECIAL SERVICES

**HANDICAPPED PARKING:** Use designated spots in lower parking lot, near check-in.  
**HANDICAPPED BATHROOMS:** Accessible port-a-potties will be available near check-in.  
**MOBILITY IMPAIRED SEATING:** Available.  
**MOBILITY IMPAIRED CHECK-IN:** Move to the front of the line and follow the AccessMat to the check-in table.  
**UNABLE TO WEAR A MASK?  
FOR ASSISTANCE:** Seating with greater social distance will be available.  
Contact Town Hall (508-349-7004 x 110 or x124) for accommodations for individuals with disabilities including assistive listening devices (ALD) and material in alternative formats.

### WHAT TO BRING

- Yourself, dressed in weather-appropriate clothing.
- A hat, if it is sunny.
- Patience.

- Please don't bring your own chair or food (unless medically required).
- Please limit gathering in groups on the field before or after the meeting.
- Please don't bring pets.
