PRESS RELEASE

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: August 6, 2021

At their Public Hearing on August 6, 2021 the Truro Board of Health voted to amend their current masking Rule and Order that requires customers and staff to wear a cloth face covering inside all business establishments, clubs and places of assembly regardless of a person's vaccination status. The amendment reminds customers of food service establishments to mask while entering the establishment and remain masked until seated; it also requires guests and workers at public lodging establishments to wear face coverings while inside hallways and common areas.

Other locations where cloth face coverings must be worn by staff and guests includes Personal Service spas or salons; when outdoors and physical separation is not possible; at outdoor gatherings on public or privately leased space where more than 100 persons are in attendance; and, on all public and private forms of transportation systems such as taxi's, ride-shares, transportation shelters and the CCRTA flex bus.

The Board of Health reminds the public that full vaccination against COVID-19 remains important to reduce hospitalization and morbidity from the virus and they encourage all eligible persons who are not fully vaccinated to get immunized.

The Truro Health Department will continue to keep the public advised of further developments regarding COVID-19.
