Week2 – With a greater focus on goals we will discuss and develop our formatting, create a prototype and start actualizing our book. Images and text will find their places through trial and error. Substrates and printing options will be brought to class for students to consider in their final printing.

Week 3 – Students will have in-class time to work on their pages, get feedback, problem solve, consider their materials and prepare for printing proof and create digital copies for printing.

Weeks 4, 5, 6 – Digital images will be prepared for printing. All the puzzle pieces of the books will be put together and bound.
