TO CONDUCT BUSINESS:

To complete Building Department applications, you may obtain permit applications [here](#) and either mail completed applications to Town Hall (Attn: Building Department) or deposit them in the Town Hall Dropbox.

To complete Health Department applications, you may obtain permit applications [here](#) and either mail completed applications to Town Hall (Attn: Health Department) or deposit them in the Town Hall Dropbox.

UPDATED 3/23: All Building/ Health inspection requests must be made by voicemail to either extension, 130 or 131. This includes inspections for Electrical, Plumbing, Gas or Building, and also Health and Conservation permits. The office voicemail will be checked Tuesdays and Thursdays until 10:30 AM. Any messages after that time will be reviewed for the following inspection day (either a Tuesday or a Thursday). Please leave us your cellphone number, the type of inspection needed and the location of the residence.
