The meeting commenced at 6:00 p.m. with a quorum and covered the following agenda:

- 1. Meeting Minutes** of the March 10, 2014 meeting were approved as amended.
- 2. Public Comments:** None.
- 3. Regional Bike Safety Plan:** Sheila Lyons, Barnstable County Commissioner, reviewed bike safety initiatives particularly related to seasonal workers. There is a meeting scheduled with Mass Bike and the police chiefs of Cape towns to provide education and outreach. Work is underway with Planet Bike to provide 2,000 bike lights. The education and outreach initiatives include working with the Council of Churches, Chambers of Commerce, bike shops, and local town events. The CIE has translated the bike safety information into additional languages for seasonal workers.
- 4. Bike Safety Programs:** The bike rodeo will be held the weekend after school ends at Corn Hill.
- 5. Bikeways Videos:** There are five videos from Road Id and three from the Helmet Safety Institute that are being made available to local towns for broadcast on town TV channels. These videos are currently being broadcast on Lower Cape TV.
- 6. Bike Safety Insert:** The town beach sticker application mailing was distributed which includes the Mass Bike spoke card safety insert.
- 7. Town Website:** The committee reviewed materials to be made available on the town web site.
- 8. Eagle Neck Culvert:** The committee voted to approve a letter to the town Board of Selectmen recommending that the Eagle Neck Culvert roadway improvement project incorporate a bike lane.
- 9. Truro Walkways and Hiking Map:** Mark Adams is tentatively scheduled for the May 12 meeting. There is potential for a joint meeting with the Wellfleet committee.
- 10. Outer Cape Bike Working Group:** No activity at this time. They will inform the town when it resumes.
- 11. Future Agenda Items:** Discuss fundraising appeal letter for bike lights and placement of bike racks in coordination with local businesses.
- 12. Next meeting** is scheduled for May 12, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. at the Truro Public Safety Facility.
