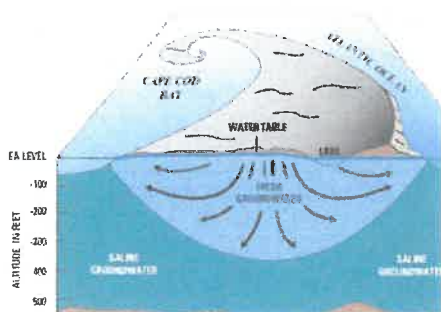
## Keeping Truro Sustainable: Planning for the Future
