# **Department News:**

# **Police Department**

- National Telecommunicators Week is April 8<sup>th</sup> to the 14<sup>th</sup> 2018. The Truro Police Department's
  Communications Division is made up of 4 full-time Dispatchers, the Administrative Assistant, 4 part-time
  Dispatchers and two Patrol Officers. All are trained in CPR/AED, APCO Public Safety
  Telecommunications, APCO Emergency Medical Dispatch, Incident Command Systems and our in-house
  State and Federal Computer systems. This week we will be honoring those members of the Truro Police
  who are the "First" First Responders.
- \$4,100.00 was raised at the Tip-a-Cop fundraiser for the Special Olympics which was held at Montano's Restaurant. Celebrity waiters from the Truro Police Department helped wait staff with serving dinner and drinks to the many generous patrons. Special thanks to Chef/Owner Bob Montano and his entire staff for their involvement in making the fundraiser successful. Thanks to everyone who came out for dinner and donated. Thanks to the Special Olympian Athletes who were on hand to greet everyone. And last but not least, this evening could not have been successful without the help of Amy Rogers and her organizational skills. The mission of Special Olympics is to provide year round sports training and athletic competition in a variety of Olympic type sports for children and adults with intellectual disabilities giving them continuing opportunities to develop physical fitness, demonstrate courage, experience joy and participate in a sharing of gifts, skills and friendship with their families, other Special Olympics Athletes and the community.

#### Fire Department

- The Department responded to 7 requests for medical assistance, resulting in 5 transports to the hospital. In all we responded to a total of 22 calls that included inspectional services, general assistance, alarm activations, calls for public service assistance and a good intent calls.
- The Department in conjunction with the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is preparing to conduct a regional training program with both Provincetown and Wellfleet. The exercise is designed to simulate a potential fuel spill in the Pamet Harbor and is designed to prepare first responders to deal with the initial phase of this type of incident. Participating agencies include: Mass DEP, Truro Fire & Police, Wellfleet and Provincetown Fire Departments, Truro, Wellfleet and Provincetown Harbormasters, the United States Coast Guard and the National Park Service. This drill will take place on 18 April at the Pamet Harbor.
- Our first new hire Demi Miskiv has entered the rotation on group B. FF Michael Chute will complete his training period this week and start in the shift rotation next week.

# Town of Truro Town Manager's Weekly Report

**April 13, 2018** 

- FF Ferguson has started his ten-week training program at the Massachusetts Fire Academy.
- FF Souza has completed the ten-week career recruit program at the Massachusetts Fire Academy in Stow. Congratulations Jeff on a job well done.
- The Department has placed into service two new automated compression devices that provide mechanical CPR to those who need it. This equipment was purchased with funds from the gifts and grants account.

### **Department of Public Works**

- The Transfer Station will be closed Patriots Day, Monday April 16, 2018.
- Scale assembly has been completed. While the concrete platform cures, staff will be trained on scale operations and software capability. Completion date is scheduled for April 25, 2018.
- Mapping and data collection has been completed by way of a drone flight from Ballston Beach over the Pamet River to the Harbor. A debrief with the Air Shark Company is scheduled for next week.
- A small portion of the Ballston Beach parking lot has been removed to allow appropriate drainage during storm event wash-overs. Split rail fencing has been installed along the border of the public access path and along the far end of the parking lot.
- Annual Transfer Station permits go on sale May 1, 2018. Permits may be purchased online through the Town website, or over the counter at Town Hall.
- The total tonnage for solid waste continues to drop. For the month of March, the Town generated 65.67 tons of solid waste. Last year, the Town produced 113.35 tons of solid waste for the month of March.

#### **Harbor Master**

- The floating docks are in the water, along with the town boat, in preparation for the upcoming boating season. The Harbormaster gathered mooring balls and checked chain and mooring blocks.
- New additional floating docks have been completed and are anticipated to arrive next week. They will be installed once the proper permits from DEP are received.
- The comment period for the Chapter 91 DEP license ended this past Monday, the license could be received within a month.
