## Town Manager's Weekly Report

May 25, 2018

### ***This week's activities of note from the Town Manager's Office:***

- On Friday May 25, 2018, Long Nook Beach access will be restored. Due to the instability and continued erosion and "slumping" of the coastal bank, beach access was severely restricted. Visitors of Long Nook may pass at their own risk and should be aware of dangerous and unstable terrain, further slumping and falling rocks and sand from above. The Town will continue to monitor the Long Nook Beach access. Please use the defined pathways to access the beach. Creating new pathways will further destabilize the coastal bank.
- Puma Park Playground reopened on Thursday May 24<sup>th</sup> after being closed for repairs. Special thanks to the team of private citizens who fundraised for the materials needed to reopen!
- On Monday evening, the Chair of the Select Board and I attended a meeting with representatives from Provincetown, Wellfleet, Orleans, Brewster and the Cape Cod National Seashore to begin a regional dialogue between the agencies.

### **Department News:**

#### Department of Public Works

- The Transfer Station is open 7 days a week. The Swap Shop will remain open three days a week (Saturday, Sunday and Monday) and closed Tuesday through Friday.
- The Transfer Station scale is now fully operational. All commercial entities are required to weigh solid waste and recyclables.
- Annual Transfer Station permits are on sale. Permits may be purchased on-line through the Town website, or over the counter at Town Hall.
- A volunteer beach clean-up is scheduled for June 2, 2018 at 10:00 am at Corn Hill Beach.

#### Harbor Master

- Boating activity is steadily increasing with boats going in for the season and reports of fish moving into Cape waters.
- Harbor Master Jackett put the remaining channel buoys in.
- Most of the floats went into the basin with only a few remaining that need repairs. All floats should be in by June 15<sup>th</sup>.
